

Kensington City-Lower Burrell [Township] City line at the end of Route 64004; thence in a westerly direction over Seventh Street Road and Seventh Street to [a point on Route 737, at Stanton Avenue and] the intersection of Seventh Street and Third Avenue, in the city of New Kensington, Westmoreland County, a distance of about [2.1] 2.29 miles.

[Beginning at the intersection of Seventh Street and Fourth Avenue, thence over Seventh Street, Third Avenue and Eleventh Street to the intersection of Eleventh Street and Fourth Avenue in the City of New Kensington, a distance of about 0.5 of a mile.]

Section 2. The act is amended by adding the following new route:
Route 64290. Beginning at the east end of the bridge over the

Allegheny River on Ninth Street in the City of New Kensington,
thence in an easterly direction over Ninth Street to Second Avenue,
thence in a southerly direction over Second Avenue to Sixth Street,
thence in an easterly direction over Sixth Street to Third Avenue,
thence in a southerly direction over Third Avenue to Second Street,
thence in an easterly direction over Second Street (being partly in
the City of New Kensington and partly in the City of Lower Burrell)
to an intersection with Application 1264 Spur E in the Cities of New
Kensington and Lower Burrell, a distance of about 1.47 miles.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

AN ACT

SB 1174

Amending the act of June 22, 1931 (P. L. 594), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," deleting a route in Cameron and Clinton Counties and adding a new route in Goshen and Lawrence Townships, Clearfield County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Route 12013, established by the act of June 22, 1931 (P. L. 594), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," and its amendments, is deleted as follows:

Cameron County

[Route 12013. Beginning at a point on Route 18048 in West Keating Township, Clinton County; thence in a northerly direction along a forestry road to its intersection with Route 12001, a distance of 14.4 miles, in West Keating Township, Clinton County, and Grove Township, Cameron County.]

Section 2. The act is amended by adding the following new route:

Clearfield County

Route ¹ 17154. Beginning at the intersection of Legislative Route 17051 and Township Road 623 in Goshen Township; thence in a northwesterly ² direction over Township Road 623 to the Goshen Township-Lawrence Township line, a distance of approximately 1.1 miles; thence continuing in a northwesterly direction over McGeorge Road, a distance of approximately 2.5 miles to a property of Pennsylvania State University's Television Station WPSX, a total distance of approximately 3.6 miles in Goshen and Lawrence Townships, Clearfield County.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately and the highway established under its provisions shall be taken over for construction and maintenance not later than January 1, 1968.
