# AN ACT

SB 12

Amending the act of August 31, 1966 (Appropriation Act No. 71-A), entitled "An act making an appropriation to the Department of Military Affairs for certain capital improvements in accordance with long-range planning for capital improvements designed to make the most effective use of the State's available resources," making the appropriation available for land acquisition at Kane armory in accordance with a recommendation of the State Armory Board.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1, act of August 31, 1966 (Appropriation Act No. 71-A), entitled "An act making an appropriation to the Department of Military Affairs for certain capital improvements in accordance with long-range planning for capital improvements designed to make the most effective use of the State's available resources," is amended to read:

Section 1. The sum of one hundred forty-two thousand four hundred dollars (\$142,400), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated to the Department of Military Affairs for capital projects for the Armory Planning and Functions program, including various types of general improvements and alterations and construction at the State armories, and for land acquisition at Kane

# armory in accordance with a recommendation of the State Armory Board.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

# AN ACT

SB 13

Making an appropriation for the support of the Council of State Governments and the Interstate Legislative Reference Bureau.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The sum of forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated for the support of the Council of State Governments and the Interstate Legislative Reference Bureau for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967. The funds are to be paid on requisition of the Auditor General and warrants for such payments to be drawn to the order of the Executive Director of the Council of State Governments who shall file an accounting of said expenses with the Auditor General as provided by the act of June 23, 1931 (P. L. 1200).

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

# No. 3-A AN ACT

SB 14

Making an appropriation to the Department of Military Affairs for the payment of expenses of the Pennsylvania National Guard ordered on active duty for State service by the Governor.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Department of Military Affairs for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1966 for the payment of expenses of elements of the Pennsylvania National Guard ordered to active duty for State service by the Governor, as provided in "The Military Code of 1949."

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

SB 15

Amending the act of September 27, 1966 (Appropriation Act No. 96A), entitled "An act making an appropriation to the Delaware River Basin Commission for the rehabilitation or reconstruction of certain wing dams on the Delaware River," increasing the appropriation.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1, act of September 27, 1966 (Appropriation Act No. 96A), entitled "An act making an appropriation to the Delaware River Basin Commission, for the rehabilitation or reconstruction of certain wing dams on the Delaware River," is amended to read:

Section 1. The sum of [one hundred sixty-two thousand five hundred dollars (\$162,500)] two hundred forty-two thousand five hundred

dollars (\$242,500), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby

appropriated to the Delaware River Basin Commission, for the rehabilitation and reconstruction of certain wing dams on the Delaware River in the vicinity of New Hope, Pennsylvania and Lambertville, New Jersey. The money so appropriated shall be expended for this purpose only to the extent that a similar amount is provided to the Commission by the State of New Jersey. Disbursements of funds for this purpose shall be administered by the Department of Forests and Waters.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

SB 16

Amending the act of August 24, 1966 (Appropriation Act No. 69-A), entitled "An act to provide for the ordinary expenses of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, interest on the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 1966, to June 30, 1967, for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1966, and for payments for the support of public schools for the fiscal period from July 1, 1966, to June 30, 1968," increasing certain appropriations to the Department of Revenue and the Department of State.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 2, act of August 24, 1966 (Appropriation Act No. 69-A), known as "The General Appropriation Act of 1966," is amended to read:

Section 2. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the General Fund to the several hereinafter named agencies of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth for the payment of the salaries, wages or other compensation and travel expense of the duly elected or appointed officers and employes of the Commonwealth, for payment of fees for contractual services rendered, for the purchase or rental of goods, services, printing, equipment, land and buildings and for payment of any other expenses, as provided by law or by this act, necessary for the proper conduct of the duties, functions and activities and for the purposes hereinafter set forth for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1966, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1966.

# No. 6-A AN ACT

SB 17

Amending the act of October 25, 1966 (Appropriation Act No. 138-A), entitled "An act making appropriations to the Department of Military Affairs for the development or improvement of airport facilities," deleting the appropriation from the Aviation Fuel Tax Account and making a similar appropriation from the General Fund.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of the act of October 25, 1966 (Appropriation Act No. 138-A), entitled "An act making appropriations to the Department of Military Affairs for the development or improvement of airport facilities," is amended to read:

Section 1. The sum of three hundred thirty thousand dollars (\$330,000), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated from the General Fund and the sum of four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated from the [Aviation Fuel Tax Account separately segregated in the Motor License Fund] General Fund to the Department of Military Affairs for the fiscal year

July 1, 1966 to June 30, 1967, to be used by the Pennsylvania Aeronautics Commission for the encouragement and development of aeronautics, for the development and maintenance of State airports, for assistance to political subdivisions and municipal authorities of the Commonwealth in the construction and improvement of airports and other aeronautical facilities, including the making of surveys and plans and the necessary construction work and equipment. The three hundred thirty thousand dollars (\$330,000) shall be used by the Pennsylvania Aeronautics Commission for airport development at the Wilkes-Barre Scranton Airport at Avoca, Luzerne County: Provided, however, That no more shall be expended from these appropriations for such purposes or any of them than may be required to match an equal sum contributed by any political subdivision or municipal authority of the Commonwealth or by the Federal government or by a political subdivision or municipal authority and the Federal government as provided in the act of May 2, 1947 (P. L. 136).

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

SB 207

Making an appropriation to the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate for the establishment and operation of a Legislative Data Processing Center.

The sum of one hundred thousand dollars or as much thereof as may be necessary is appropriated to the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate jointly to be used for the establishment and operation of a Legislative Data Processing Center. The expenses covered by this appropriation shall include, but not be limited to, site preparation, rental of equipment, necessary professional, technical, and clerical assistance, purchase of supplies and all other necessary expenses.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

The following sums, or as much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the General Fund to the several hereinafter named agencies of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth for the payment of the salaries, wages or other compensation and travel expense of the duly elected or appointed officers and employes of the Commonwealth, for payment of fees for contractual services rendered, for the purchase or rental of goods, services, printing, equipment, land and buildings and for payment of any other expenses, as provided by law or by this act, necessary for the proper conduct of the duties, functions and activities, and for the purposes hereinafter set forth for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1966, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1966.

Section 1. The sum of three thousand eight hundred dollars (\$3,800), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appro-

priated to the National Governors' Conference as the Commonwealth's contribution toward the financing of the programs and operations of the Conference for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967. Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

Making an appropriation to the General Assembly for the payment of expenses of its Inaugural Committee.

The sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000), or as much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated to the General Assembly for the payment of the expenses of its Inaugural Committee in making and carrying out the arrangements for the Inauguration of the Governor-elect on January 17, 1967.

Section 2. Whatsoever of the amount herein appropriated is unexpended or unencumbered as of June 30, 1967 shall lapse.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

#### SB 896

Making an appropriation to the State Treasurer for the purpose of paying salaries and wages of State officers and employes and other ordinary and general expenses in the interim between June 30, 1967 and such time as the funds provided by the General Appropriation Act and other appropriation acts become available.

Whereas, Under the Constitution and the laws of this Commonwealth, the State Treasurer may not pay out any moneys unless they be specifically appropriated by act of the General Assembly; therefore

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The sum of two hundred million dollars (\$200,000,-000), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated to the State Treasurer of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for the purpose of paying the salaries and wages of the officers and employes and other ordinary and general expenses of the State government in the interim between June 30, 1967 and such time as moneys appropriated by the General Appropriation Act and other appropriation acts of 1967 may become available for such purposes; and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967.

Section 2. Payments out of the appropriation of this act shall be made by the State Treasurer upon requisitions by the several departments, boards, commissions or officers in the same manner as payments are ordinarily made.

Section 3. All amounts paid by the State Treasurer in accordance with this act shall be charged against the appropriations made for the salaries and wages of the officers and employes and other ordinary and general expenses of the State government in the General Appropriation Act and other appropriation acts of 1967.

Section 4. This act shall become effective immediately.

In addition to this amount, all moneys received from the Federal Government, or from any other source as contributions for this program. shall be paid into the General Fund and credited to this appropria-The Department of Public Welfare shall allocate funds from tion. time to time for administrative expenses of the several county boards of assistance, for such administrative expenses incurred by the department which are chargeable to such boards and for the payment of attorney's fees and court costs necessary for the proper conduct of the public assistance programs: Provided, That any rule or regulation adopted by the Secretary of Public Welfare during the fiscal year 1967-68 which adds to the cost of any public assistance program shall only be effective from and after the date upon which it is approved as to availability of funds by the Governor.

Section 2. The sum of one hundred ninety-five thousand three hundred eighty-five dollars (\$195,385), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated to the Department of Public Welfare for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1967 and for the payment of administrative expenses incurred prior to and remaining unpaid June 30, 1967, for payment by quarterly allocation to the Treasury Department in such amounts as may be deemed necessary for the administrative expenses of such department in disbursing appropriations for or relating to public assistance, including any Federal sums supplementing such appropriations. Such allocations shall be made by the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House of Representatives, Secretary of Public Welfare and the State Treasurer or a majority thereof.

Section 3. The sum of one hundred eighty-two thousand five hundred twenty-six dollars (\$182,526), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated to the Department of Public Welfare for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1967 and for the payment of administrative expenses incurred prior to and remaining unpaid June 30, 1967, for payment by quarterly allocation to the Department of the Auditor General in such amounts as may be deemed necessary for the administrative expenses of such department in auditing appropriations for or relating to public assistance, including any Federal sums supplementing such appropriations. Such allocations shall be made by the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House of Representatives, Secretary of Public Welfare and the Auditor General, or a majority thereof.

Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.

SB 852

Making an appropriation from the Korean Conflict Veterans' Compensation Fund to the Department of Military Affairs for certain administration expenses necessary for the payment of compensation to veterans as provided by the Korean Conflict Veterans' Compensation Act.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The sum of twenty-six thousand fifty-one dollars (\$26,051), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the Korean Conflict Veterans' Compensation Fund to the Department of Military Affairs for the fiscal year July 1, 1967 to June 30, 1968, for the purpose of paying salaries, wages, postage, printing and other necessary expenses incurred in payment of compensation to veterans as provided by the Korean Conflict Veterans' Compensation Act.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1967.

SB 853

Making an appropriation out of the Feed and Fertilizer Fund to the Department of Agriculture to augment the General Government Operations appropriation for the Food Regulation and Testing Program.

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Section 1. The sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200.000). or as much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated out of the Feed and Fertilizer Fund to the Department of Agriculture to augment the General Government Operations appropriation for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1967 to June 30, 1968. These funds are to be used specifically for the Food Regulation and Testing Program in accordance with the purposes cited in the acts of May 29, 1956 (P. L. 1795), June 5, 1957 (P. L. 248), August 8, 1961 (P. L. 971), and September 1, 1965 (P. L. 436). Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1. 1967.

SB 854

Making an appropriation out of the Motor License Fund to the Department of Public Instruction to promote highway safety education.

Section 1. The sum of fifteen thousand one hundred eight dollars (\$15,108), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the Motor License Fund to the Department of Public Instruction for the fiscal year July 1, 1967 to June 30, 1968 for the purpose of promoting highway safety education through the schools in this Commonwealth.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1967.

Section 1. The sum of one hundred five thousand four hundred four dollars (\$105,404), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the Motor License Fund to the Department of Revenue for the Hazardous Substances Transportation Board for the fiscal year July 1, 1967 to June 30, 1968, for the purpose of regulating the transportation of hazardous substances on highways and toll roads, including the Pennsylvania Turnpike, and for carrying out the purposes of the act of November 9, 1965 (P. L. 657).

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1967.

The sum of six hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$660,-000), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated to the Department of Military Affairs for the fiscal year July 1, 1967 to June 30, 1968 to provide assistance to veterans and their dependents as provided in the act of November 10, 1959 (P. The sum of seven million eight hundred sixty-five thousand seventy-eight dollars (\$7,865,078), or as much thereof as may be necessary, from the various funds of the Commonwealth and in the amounts hereinafter listed, is hereby appropriated to the Department of Labor and Industry for payment into the Social Security Contribution Fund created under the provisions of the act of January 5, 1952 (P. L. 1833), as reenacted and amended by the act of June 1, 1956 (P. No. 30-A AN ACT

SB 757

Making an appropriation to the Department of Justice for the payment of a claim of the United States against the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Findings of Fact.—The Pennsylvania General Assembly, by act of May 31, 1945, P. L. 1212, authorized the acquisition of lands and the erection of buildings for the Pennsylvania Maritime Academy, which academy was subsequently determined to be located at Delaware River and Biles Creek, Pennsylvania.

The War Shipping Administration and the Maritime Commission of the United States were authorized by Public Law 630 of the 79th Congress, approved August 7, 1946, to make available or transfer to any state maintaining a maritime school or nautical branch, excess or surplus material, supplies and equipment for use in connection with the teaching and training of midshipmen, at such ports or other locations as might be designated by such state.

Pursuant thereto, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania received at the Pennsylvania Maritime Academy at Delaware River and Biles Creek, certain surplus or excess material, supplies and equipment from agencies of the United States government during September to December, 1946, which the United States valued at five hundred thousand eighty-four dollars and twenty-one cents (\$500,084.21).

The Pennsylvania General Assembly, by act of May 22, 1947, P. L. 268, directed that the affairs of the Pennsylvania Nautical School be wound up and its existence be terminated as soon as practicable.

Thereafter, during the year 1947, the Secretary of Property and Supplies authorized the various departments and agencies of the Commonwealth to remove the United States donated property to their departments or schools for Commonwealth use.

Subsequently the United States Maritime Commission, in 1958, renewed its demand for return of the donated property, or payment of its value, and thereafter, in March of 1963, suit was instituted by the United States against the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in the United States District Court, Middle District of Pennsylvania, to No. 8051 for damages in the amount of five hundred thousand eighty-four dollars and twenty-one cents (\$500,084.21), plus interest.

From said time until the present, negotiations were carried on between the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and representatives of the United States Department of Justice relating to an amicable adjustment of said claim. On March 16, 1967, a settlement of the claim was reached in the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).

Section 2. Appropriation.—The sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), or as much thereof as is necessary, is appropriated to the Department of Justice for the purpose of paying the claim of the United States against the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania described in section 1 of this act.

Section 3. Effective Date.—This act shall take effect immediately.
