Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.

AN ACT

SB 771

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P. L. 1225), entitled "An act concerning game and other wild birds and wild animals; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," providing for the bond to be given by issuing agents.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The second paragraph of section 311, act of June 3, 1937 (P. L. 1225), known as "The Game Law," amended March 9, 1945 (P. L. 39), is amended to read:

Section 311. Agents to Collect and Remit License Fees; Reports; Compensation.— * * *

Every agent designated to issue hunters' licenses, unless already under bond to cover the handling of public funds, shall give bond to the Commonwealth in such sum as shall be fixed by the Secretary of Revenue, but not less than [one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) nor more than three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00)] three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) for each place where licenses are issued before the annual supply of licenses is delivered to him. If an agent has more than one place where licenses are issued he may supply a blanket bond covering all places.
