Section 2. The deed of conveyance shall be approved by the Department of Justice and shall be executed by the Secretary of Property and Supplies in the name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Section 3. When any part of the land so conveyed is no longer being used by the school district for school purposes it shall be conveyed to the Commonwealth for a consideration of one dollar (\$1).

Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.

AN ACT

HB 1940

Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P. L. 323), entitled "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," authorizing payments in lieu of taxes in certain cases.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of August 9, 1955 (P. L. 323), known as "The County Code," is amended by adding after section 2302, a new section to read:

Section 2302.1. Payments in Lieu of Taxes.—Where real property of the county is not presently being used for the purposes for which it was acquired, (as in the case of long-range acquisition programs for parks, dams and the like), the county may make payments in lieu of taxes for such property to local governments in which the property is located.
