Amending the act of December 15, 1959 (P. L. 1779), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to fish, frogs, tadpoles and turtles; and amending, revising, consolidating and changing the law relating to fish in the inland waters and the boundary lakes and boundary rivers of the Commonwealth," changing the name "fish warden" to "waterways patrolman."

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 3, act of December 15, 1959 (P. L. 1779), known as "The Fish Law of 1959," is amended by adding, at the end thereof, a new clause to read:

Section 3. Definitions .- As used in this act-

(5) "Fish warden" shall mean and shall be known as "waterways

patrolman."

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P. L. 30), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," authorizing the appointment of assistant solicitors.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 406, act of March 10, 1949 (P. L. 30), known as the "Public School Code of 1949," is amended to read:

Section 406. Solicitor and Other Appointees.—Each board of school directors may appoint a solicitor, such assistant solicitors and

such other appointees, clerks or employes as it may deem proper, none of whom, except as provided in section three hundred twenty-
