## AN ACT

SB 1550

Amending the act of May 11, 1911 (P. L. 275), entitled "An act to provide for the appointment of county and city inspectors of weights and measures; providing for their compensation and expenses: prescribing their duties; prohibiting vendors from giving false or insufficient weights; and fixing the penalties for the violation of the provisions hereof," transferring the duties of the Secretary of Internal Affairs to the Attorney General.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The first paragraph of section 2, act of May 11, 1911 (P. L. 275), entitled "An act to provide for the appointment of county and city inspectors of weights and measures; providing for their compensation and expenses; prescribing their duties; prohibiting vendors from giving false or insufficient weights; and fixing the penalties for the violation of the provisions 'hereof," amended July 31, 1941 (P. L. 614), is amended to read:

Section 2. That all county and city inspectors so appointed shall be supplied, at the expense of their respective counties and cities, with standard tests of weights and measures, in conformity with those established by the Government of the United States or the Bureau of Standards of the State, and the laws of this Commonwealth; and to ensure the accuracy of these tests they shall be compared with the standard tests to be purchased by the [Secretary of Internal Affairs] Attorney General, and, when so compared and their correctness estab-

lished, a certificate of accuracy shall be issued, said certificate to bear the date of examination and approval of the said weight or measure for which the certificate is issued, the signature of the examiner and the official stamp of the Department of Justice.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
