AN ACT

HB 374

Empowering cities of the first class, coterminous with school districts of the first class, to authorize the boards of education of such school districts to impose an additional tax on real estate for 1969 for public school purposes, and provide for the levy, assessment, and collection of such taxes.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Any city of the first class may authorize any school district of the first class coterminous therewith, to levy during the year 1969, for the year 1969, an additional tax of four and one-quarter mills on each dollar of the total assessment of all real property assessed and certified for taxation in said district.

Section 2. The tax and penalties collected under the provisions of this act shall be used by such school districts for general public school purposes.

Section 3. The tax authorized to be levied under provisions of this act shall be levied for the calendar year 1969, and shall be in addition to any other tax any school district of the first class is empowered to levy and collect under any existing law.

Section 4. The taxes which are levied under the provisions of this act shall be collected, at the same time, in the same manner, with like authority, and subject to the same discounts and penalties, as other real estate taxes for school purposes in school districts of the first class are collected.

Section 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
