Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P. L. 103), entitled "An act concerning townships of the second class; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," authorizing payment of expenses of township officers and employes when attending certain conferences, institutes and schools.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (h) of section 516, act of May 1, 1933 (P. L. 103), known as "The Second Class Township Code," reenacted and amended July 10, 1947 (P. L. 1481), and amended September 22, 1961 (P. L. 1594), is amended to read:

Section 516. Duties of Supervisors, Township Superintendents, and Roadmasters.—The township supervisors, or the supervisors employed as superintendents or roadmasters, shall—

. * * *

(h) Attend road meetings and conventions authorized by the provisions of this act when directed to do so by the board of supervisors. Any supervisor, *elected or appointed officer* or qualified township employe may, if directed by the board of supervisors, attend any *conference, institute or* school conducted [in the State by a State or Federal agency] within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in order to discuss and resolve the various questions arising in the discharge of the duties and functions of the respective officers and employes, and to provide uniform, efficient and economical methods of administering their township duties. The expenses for attending the conferences, institutes and schools may be paid by the township and shall be limited to the registration fee, mileage at the rate of ten cents (10¢) per circular mile, and room and board at the rate of twenty dollars (\$20) per day.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
