Amending the act of July 20, 1968 (Act No. 218), entitled "An act implementing the provisions of clause (4) of subsection (a) of section 7 of Article VIII of the Constitution of Pennsylvania by providing for the capital budget for the fiscal year 1968-1969 as required therein," clarifying the time during which bonds may be issued for highway projects and adding additional projects.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 3, act of July 20, 1968 (Act No. 218), known as the "Capital Budget Act for the 1968-1969 Fiscal Year," is amended by adding the following new projects:

Section 3. Capital Budget—Itemization of Projects.—* * *

(b) The capital projects in the category of highway projects to be financed by the incurring of debt and to be constructed by the State Highway and Bridge Authority, its successors or assigns, are hereby itemized, together with their respective estimated financial costs as follows:

Section 2. The next to last paragraph of subsection (b) of section 3 of the act, amended April 1, 1969 (Act No. 7), is amended to read:

Section 3. Capital Budget—Itemization of Projects.—• • •

(b) The capital projects in the category of highway projects to be financed by the incurring of debt and to be constructed by the State Highway and Bridge Authority, its successors or assigns, are hereby itemized, together with their respective estimated financial costs as follows:

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Contingency.—Additional funds to be allocated by the Board of the State Highway and Bridge Authority to such of the foregoing highway projects specifically itemized in a capital budget for construction by the State Highway and Bridge Authority, as are not bid within the estimated financial costs specified in such capital budget, but this amount shall not otherwise constitute unallocated funds of the State Highway and Bridge Authority for any other purpose.

Section 3. The introductory paragraph of section 4, of the act is amended to read:

Section 4. Over-all Limitations on Debt to be Incurred [in Fiscal Year] for Capital Projects without Approval of the Electors.—The capital projects to be financed by the proceeds of debt to be incurred during the fiscal year 1968-1969 and the ensuing fiscal year 1969-1970 and until superseded by a permanent capital budget for such fiscal year, the aggregate amounts of debt to be incurred during such fiscal [year] years pursuant to clause (4) of subsection (a) of section 7 of Article VIII of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and the fund to be charged with the repayment of such debt are as follows:

Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
