Designating United States Highway Route No. 80 in Pennsylvania as the "Keystone Shortway."

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. United States Highway Route No. 80 in Pennsylvania extending from the Pennsylvania and New Jersey boundary line at or near Stroudsburg to the Pennsylvania and Ohio boundary line at or near Sharon, Pennsylvania is hereby designated and shall be known as the "Keystone Shortway."

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
