AN ACT

HB 1600

Amending the act of January 10, 1968 (P. L. 925), entitled "An act relating to officers and employes of the General Assembly; fixing the number, qualifications, compensation, mileage and duties of the officers and employes of the Senate and of the House of Representatives; providing for their election or appointment, term of office, or of service, removal and manner of filling vacancies; fixing the salary of the Director of the Legislative Reference Bureau; providing for compilation of lists of employes," providing for increased compensation for each person whose compensation is fixed by this act.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Article III, act of January 10, 1968 (P. L. 925), entitled "An act relating to officers and employes of the General Assembly; fixing the number, qualifications, compensation, mileage and duties of the officers and employes of the Senate and of the House of Representatives; providing for their election or appointment, term of office, or of service, removal and manner of filling vacancies; fixing the salary of the Director of the Legislative Reference Bureau; providing for compilation of lists of employes," is amended by adding a new section to read:

ARTICLE III

Provisions Applicable to Both Senate and House of Representatives

Section 51. In addition to the amounts specified heretofore, each person, other than a member of the General Assembly, whose compensation is fixed in this act, shall be paid an amount equal to ten per cent of the compensation specified, prorated to each pay period, beginning with the pay period during which this amendatory act becomes effective and continuing thereafter.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
