Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P. L. 1333), entitled "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, primary and election expenses and election contests; creating and defining membership of county boards of elections; imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to elections," further providing for voter instruction on demonstration model voting machines.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

- Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 1216, act of June 3, 1937 (P. L. 1333), known as the "Pennsylvania Election Code," is amended to read: Section 1216. Instructions of Voters and Manner of Voting in Districts in Which Voting Machines are Used.—
- (a) In districts in which voting machines are used, the election officers shall, with the aid of the diagrams authorized by this act and the mechanically operated model, instruct each elector before he enters the voting machine booth regarding the operation of the machine, and shall give the elector opportunity personally to operate the model. In election districts using full-scale models listing the actual ballot labels for the primary or election as the case may be, any elector who desires a demonstration on such full-size scale model shall have the right to select any registered elector who is legally entitled to be inside the polling place under the provisions of this act to give such elector a demonstration.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
