SB 328

To abolish differences in classification of imprisonment.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Distinctions between all classes and types of imprisonment are hereby abolished and all sentences to imprisonment for any offense shall specify imprisonment only notwithstanding the provisions of any act prescribing any classification of imprisonment hereby abolished.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
