Amending the act of May 18, 1945 (P.L.809), entitled "An act removing certain roads or sections of road from the State highway system; and providing for their future maintenance and construction," removing a road in the City of Altoona, Blair County, from the State highway system.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1, act of May 18, 1945 (P.L.809), entitled "An act removing certain roads or sections of road from the State highway system; and providing for their future maintenance and construction," is amended by adding the following route:

Section 1. The following described roads which were added to the State highway system under the provisions of the act, approved the twenty-seventh day of April, one thousand nine hundred twenty-seven (Pamphlet Laws, four hundred nine), entitled "An act authorizing the Secretary of Highways to join two or more State highway routes, by the construction of connecting roads, under certain conditions, and providing for the payment of damages for land taken in the construction of such connecting roads," and which have been numbered by the Secretary of Highways, as indicated, are hereby removed from the said system.

BLAIR COUNTY

Route 07026 Spur E. The section of highway in the City of Altoona, Blair County, designated in the records of the Department of Highways as Route 07026 Spur E, beginning at a point on Route 07026 at the intersection of Howard Avenue and Fourth Street and extending in a generally northeasterly direction over Howard Avenue to its intersection with Chestnut Avenue, a distance of about 0.49 mile.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
