Amending the act of August 5, 1941 (P.L.752), entitled "An act regulating and improving the civil service of certain departments and agencies of the Commonwealth; vesting in the State Civil Service Commission and a Personnel Director certain powers and duties; providing for classification of positions, adoption of compensation schedules and certification of payrolls; imposing duties upon certain officers and employes of the Commonwealth; authorizing service to other State departments or agencies and political subdivisions of the Commonwealth in matters relating to civil service; defining certain crimes and misdemeanors; imposing penalties; making certain appropriations, and repealing certain acts and parts thereof," further providing for the classification of temporary employes.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

- Section 1. Subclause (4) of clause (c) of section 3, act of August 5, 1941 (P.L.752), known as the "Civil Service Act," amended August 27, 1963 (P.L.1257), is amended to read:
- Section 3. Definition of Terms.—In this act, unless the context otherwise clearly requires,—
- (c) "Unclassified service" includes all positions now existing or hereafter created in departments and agencies included in clause (d) of this section, which are held by:
- (4) Any person [temporarily appointed or designated to render special services or to make or conduct a special inquiry, investigation or examination where such appointment or designation is certified by the commission to be for employment for not more than six months in any twelve month period,] appointed for the duration of a special study, project, or internship which is scheduled to be completed after a fixed or limited period of time and which, for reasons set forth in the minutes of the commission, should not be performed by persons in the classified service.
