Amending the act of June 24, 1939 (P.L.872), entitled "An act to consolidate, amend and revise the penal laws of the Commonwealth," increasing the maximum penalty for disorderly conduct.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 406, act of June 24, 1939 (P.L.872), known as "The Penal Code," is amended to read:

Section 406. Disorderly Conduct.—Whoever wilfully makes or causes to be made any loud, boisterous and unseemly noise or disturbance to the annoyance of the peaceable residents near by, or near to any public highway, road, street, lane, alley, park, square, or common, whereby the public peace is broken or disturbed or the traveling public annoyed, is guilty of the offense of disorderly conduct, and upon conviction thereof in a summary proceeding, shall be sentenced to pay the costs of prosecution and to pay a fine not exceeding [ten dollars (\$10)] thirty dollars (\$30) and in default of the payment thereof, shall be imprisoned for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days.
