## AN ACT

## HB 1564

Amending the act of April 4, 1929 (P.L.144), entitled "An act prescribing the powers and duties of the Department of Agriculture with regard to farm products; providing for co-operation with the Department of Internal Affairs to establish standard receptacles for farm products; authorizing the Department of Agriculture to establish and promulgate standards for the grade and other classification of farm products, and to promulgate regulations for the enforcement thereof; defining farm products to include agricultural, horticultural, vegetable, fruit, and floricultural products of the soil, live stock and meats, wool, hides, poultry, eggs, dairy products, nuts, mushrooms, and honey; and providing penalties," making it unlawful for certain persons to pack or sell farm products in certain receptacles.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The fourth paragraph of section 2, act of April 4, 1929 (P.L.144), entitled "An act prescribing the powers and duties of the Department of Agriculture with regard to farm products; providing for co-operation with the Department of Internal Affairs to establish standard receptacles for farm products; authorizing the Department of Agriculture to establish and promulgate standards for the grade and other classification of farm products, and to promulgate regulations for the enforcement thereof; defining farm products to include agricultural, horticultural, vegetable, fruit, and floricultural products of the soil, live stock and meats, wool, hides, poultry, eggs, dairy products, nuts, mushrooms, and honey; and providing penalties," is amended to read:

Section 2. \* \* \*

Whenever any requirement for the marking, branding, or labeling of a receptacle for a farm product becomes effective under this act, it shall be unlawful for any person thereafter to pack for sale, offer for sale, consign for sale, or sell, **[and] or** deliver, any such farm product in a receptacle to which such requirement is applicable, unless the receptacle be marked, branded or labeled according to such requirement. **[or unless such product be brought from outside the Commonwealth and offered for sale, consigned for sale, or sold in the original package.]**
