Amending the act of May 27, 1953 (P.L.244), entitled "An act relating to and regulating the contracts of incorporated towns and providing penalties," requiring advertising for making certain contracts or purchases.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Clause (2) of subsection (d) of section 2, act of May 27, 1953 (P.L.244), entitled "An act relating to and regulating the contracts of incorporated towns and providing penalties," amended June 25, 1968 (Act No. 120), is amended to read:

Section 2. Regulation of Contracts.—* * *

(d) The contracts or purchases made by council involving an expenditure of over one thousand five hundred dollars which shall not require advertising or bidding as hereinbefore provided are as follows:

* * *

(2) Those made for improvements, repairs and maintenance of any kind [**other than construction materials used in a street improvement**] made or provided by any incorporated town through its own employes: *Provided, That all materials used for street improvement, maintenance and/or construction in excess of one thousand five hundred dollars be subject to the advertising requirements contained herein.*

* * *

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
