Amending the act of February 1, 1966 (P.L.1656), entitled "An act concerning boroughs, and revising, amending and consolidating the law relating to boroughs," requiring advertising for certain contracts or purchases.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Clause (2) of subsection (d) of section 1402, act of February 1, 1966 (P.L.1656), known as "The Borough Code," is amended to read:

Section 1402. Regulation of Contracts.—\* \* \*

(d) The contracts or purchases made by council, involving an expenditure of over one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500), which shall not require advertising or bidding as hereinbefore provided, are as follows:

\* \* \*

(2) Those made for improvements, repairs and maintenance of any kind, made or provided by any borough, through its own employees [**provided this shall not apply to construction materials used in a street improvement**]: *Provided, That all materials used for street improvement, maintenance and/or construction in excess of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) be subject to the advertising requirements contained herein;*

\* \* \*

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
