## AN ACT

HB 982

Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206), entitled "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the law relating thereto," requiring advertising for purchase of certain materials.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Clause (2) of subsection (d) of section 1802, act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206), known as "The First Class Township Code," reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955), is amended to read:

Section 1802. General Regulations Concerning Contracts. + \* \*

- (d) The contracts or purchases made by the commissioners involving an expenditure of over one thousand five hundred dollars, which shall not require advertising or bidding, as hereinbefore provided, are as follows:
- (2) Those made for improvements, repairs and maintenance of any kind made or provided by any township, through its own employes: Provided, however, That [this shall not apply to construction materials used in a street improvement] all materials used for street improvement, maintenance, and/or construction in excess of one thousand five hundred dollars be subject to the advertising requirements as contained herein.

\* \* \*

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
