## AN ACT

SB 1317

Amending the act of November 18, 1968 (Act No. 322), entitled "An act providing for the certification of sewage treatment plant and waterworks operators; creating the State Board for Certification of Sewage Treatment Plant and Waterworks Operators and prescribing its powers and duties; conferring powers and duties upon the Department of Health; and providing penalties," changing the date of expiration for operators' certificates and for their issuance by the department.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 12, act of November 18, 1968 (Act No. 322), known as the "Sewage Treatment Plant and Waterworks Operators' Certification Act," is amended to read:

Section 12. Fees.—Each application for certification as operator shall be accompanied by a fee of ten dollars (\$10). Certificates shall expire on the last day of [December] June of the first even-numbered year following the year of their issuance and must be renewed biennially in the manner prescribed by the [Secretary of Health] department. The renewal fee shall be three dollars (\$3).

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
