Amending the act of June 29, 1953 (P.L.304), entitled "An act providing for the administration of a statewide system of vital statistics; prescribing the functions of the State Department of Health, the State Advisory Health Board and local registrars; imposing duties upon coroners, prothonotaries, clerks of orphans' court, physicians, midwives and other persons; requiring reports and certificates for the registration of vital statistics; prescribing the disposition of dead bodies; limiting the disclosure of records; prescribing the sufficiency of vital statistics; records as evidence; prescribing fees and penalties; and revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto," increasing local registrars' compensation.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 304, act of June 29, 1953 (P.L.304), known as the "Vital Statistics Law of 1953," is amended to read:

Section 304. Registration Districts: Local Registrars' Compensation. Each local registrar shall be paid a fee of [fifty cents (\$.50)] one dollar (\$1) for each certificate transmitted in accordance with the provisions of this act or for each report of no certificates filed during any calendar month. The Advisory Health Board, by regulation, may establish and from time to time revise, maximum limits upon the aggregate amount of fees to be paid any local registrars during a given period. The fees prescribed by this section shall be paid by the Commonwealth from funds appropriated to the department.
