Amending the act of June 1, 1959 (P.L.350), entitled "An act relating to the retirement of public school employes; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," extending the time during which contributions can be made on account of certain past service.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (6) of section 302, act of June 1, 1959 (P.L.350), known as the "Public School Employes' Retirement Code of 1959," amended September 18, 1961 (P.L.1466), is amended to read:

Section 302. Members' Contributions on Account of Past Service.—

* * *

(6) Any school employe entitled to credit under the provisions of article II. section 209 shall pay, in addition to the regular contributions required in section 301 of this article, a sum equal to all back payments which he would have been required to make for the period of his approved leave of absence [, **and in addition a sum equal to all contributions which would have been made on his behalf by the school district and the Commonwealth**] if [the employe] *he* had been in full-time regular daily attendance rather than on leave of absence, *together with an equal additional amount as the equivalent of the contribution of the school district and the Commonwealth.* Such back payments may be made in a lump sum, by installments or by an increased rate of contribution agreed upon between the contributor and the retirement board. [: **Provided, however, That all such payments must be made on or before July 1, 1962**]

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
