Amending the act of May 15, 1969 (P.L.40), entitled "An act authorizing the issue and sale of bonds by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for the payment of compensation to certain veterans; creating a special fund in the State Treasury to be known as the Vietnam Conflict Veterans' Compensation Fund; defining the powers and duties of the Governor, the Auditor General, the State Treasurer, and the Board of Finance and Revenue in relation thereto; and providing for the payment of interest on and the redemption and refunding of such bonds; and making an appropriation," increasing the amount that may be borrowed.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 2, act of May 15, 1969 (P.L.40), known as the "Vietnam Conflict Veterans' Compensation Bond Act," is amended to read:

Section 2. Authority to Borrow.—The Governor, the Auditor General and the State Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to borrow, on the credit of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, such sum or sums of money not exceeding in the aggregate, at any one time, the sum of [twenty-eight million dollars (\$28,000,000)] *fifty-five million dollars* (\$55,000,000) as may be found necessary to carry out the purposes of the act of July 18, 1968 (Act No. 183), known as the "Vietnam Conflict Veterans' Compensation Act."

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
