A SUPPLEMENT

SB 1324

To the act of November 25, 1969 (P.L.310), entitled "An act providing for the capital budget for the fiscal year 1969-1970," itemizing community college projects of the State Public School Building Authority, together with their estimated financial costs, and the amount to be financed by debt.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Short Title.—This supplement shall be known and may be cited as the "Capital Budget Act for Fiscal Year 1969-1970, Community College Project Itemization Supplement."

Section 2. Itemization and Authorization of Projects.—Additional capital projects in the category of community college projects to be acquired or constructed by the State Public School Building Authority, its successors or assigns, and to be financed in part by the incurring of debt, are hereby itemized, together with their respective estimated financial costs and the amount to be financed by debt as follows:

- (1) Community College of Allegheny County;
 

Boyce Campus, Phase I .....	\$ 7,500,000
(Base project cost \$6,000,000)	
- (2) Community College of Allegheny County;
 

South Campus, Phase II .....	12,250,000
(Base project cost \$10,000,000)	

Section 3. Allocation of Funds.—Whenever as determined by the State Public School Building Authority, the full estimated financial costs of any of the community college projects itemized in section 2 hereof is not necessary for the proper design, acquisition or construction of such project, the excess funds no longer required may be allocated by the State Public School Building Authority to increase the estimated cost of any one or more of the community college projects specifically itemized in a capital budget.

Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
