Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103), entitled "An act concerning townships of the second class; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," further providing for the compensation of the secretary of the county association.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 603, act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103), known as "The Second Class Township Code," reenacted and amended July 10, 1947 (P.L.1481) and amended May 20, 1949 (P.L.1562), is amended to read:

Section 603. Officers of County Association.—The officers of the association shall consist of a president, two vice-presidents, a secretary, and a treasurer, none of whom shall be interested directly or indirectly in the promotion or sale of road material and equipment, and all of whom, except the secretary, shall be members of the association, and shall hold office for one year or until their successors are chosen. If desirable, the secretary may be a person not a regular member of the association, and may be paid for his service such compensation, not exceeding [twenty-five] fifty dollars per annum, as the other officers may determine. Every township supervisor, assessor, tax collector, and auditor attending such convention may vote in the election of officers.
