## AN ACT

HB 2023

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225), entitled "An act concerning game and other wild birds and wild animals; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," increasing penalties for resisting inspection or arrest, refusal to accompany officer after arrest and for interfering with an officer in the performance of his duty.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1207, act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225), known as "The Game Law," is amended to read:

Section 1207. Penalty for Resisting Arrest.—Any person who by force, menace, threat, or in any manner resists inspection or arrest for violation of any of the provisions of this act, or refuses to go with an officer after an arrest has been made, or interferes with any officer of the Commonwealth in the performance of his duty under the provisions of this act, shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of [one] *two* hundred dollars and costs of prosecution, and, in default of the payment of such fine [and costs], shall be imprisoned one day for each dollar of fine [and costs].
