The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The fees to be received by the prothonotary of the trial division of the Court of Common Pleas in Philadelphia, and as clerk of the family division of the said court, shall be as follows:

Section 2. The fee for any paper or service not herein specially provided for shall be the same as for a similar service.

Section 3. The fees hereinbefore enumerated shall be exclusive of any tax now levied or that may hereafter be levied.

Section 4. The prothonotary shall not be required to receive any paper or perform any service until the proper fee is paid.

Section 5. The jury fee when paid shall not be refunded.

Section 6. (a) The act of July 30, 1963 (P.L.344) entitled "An act fixing fees to be received by the prothonotary in counties of the first class; and providing for the time of payment," is repealed.

(b) All other acts or parts of acts are repealed in so far as they are inconsistent herewith.

Section 7. This act shall take effect thirty days after final enactment.
