Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225), entitled "An act concerning game and other wild birds and wild animals; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," changing the place at which commission meetings must be held.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 204, act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225), known as "The Game Law," amended September 8, 1959 (P.L.809), is amended to read: Section 204. Meetings of Commission; Election of Officers.—The commission shall have an office at [the Capitol] Harrisburg, and shall hold meetings at [such office] Harrisburg in January and June or July, and at such other times and places within the State as the commission shall appoint, for the transaction of business. At the meeting held in January of each year, the commission shall elect one of its members as president and one of its members as vice-president. Such officers shall hold office for a period of one year.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
