Amending the act of June 1, 1933 (P.L.1172), entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," changing a route in Wernersville Borough in Berks County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The following route established by section 2, act of June 1, 1933 (P.L.1172), entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," and its amendments is amended to read:

Route 06148. Extending Route 06148.—Beginning at a point on North Elm Street at the Lower Heidelberg Township—Wernersville Borough Line; thence in a southerly direction over North Elm Street [and South Elm Street] to an intersection with *Penn Avenue; thence beginning again at a point at the intersection of Penn Avenue and Furnace Road; thence in a southerly direction over Furnace Road to a point on* Lincoln Drive; thence in a southeasterly direction over Lincoln Drive to its intersection with Hill Road (Legislative Route 06066), in the Borough of Wernersville, Berks County, a distance of about [0.58] 0.98 of a mile.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
