## AN ACT

SB 893

Amending the act of June 1, 1933 (P.L.1172), entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," deleting certain routes in Brentwood Borough.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The following routes established by section 2, act of June 1, 1933 (P.L.1172), entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," are hereby deleted.

[Route 02093. Extending Route 02093.—Beginning at a point on the Brentwood Borough-Baldwin Township line, thence in a northwesterly direction on Willet Avenue to an intersection with Churchview Avenue in the borough of Brentwood, Allegheny County, a distance of about .46 of a mile.

Route 02097. Extending Route 02097.—Beginning at a point on the Brentwood Borough-Baldwin Township line, thence in a north and westerly direction on East Willock Road to its intersection with the Brownsville Road in the borough of Brentwood, Allegheny County, a distance of about .5 of a mile.]
