Amending the act of June 22, 1931 (P.L.594), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," deleting certain routes in Allegheny County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The following routes established by the act of June 22, 1931 (P.L.594), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," are deleted:

[Route 02093. Beginning at a point on the Brentwood Borough line about .25 of a mile south of Glass Run Road, thence in a southeasterly direction to an intersection with the Streets Run Road, in Allegheny County, a distance of about 1.66 miles:

Route 02097. Beginning at the Streets Run Road near Willock, and extending in a northwesterly direction to the Brentwood Borough line, in Allegheny County, a distance of about 1.2 miles.]

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
