Amending the act of June 24, 1939 (P.L.872), entitled "An act to consolidate, amend and revise the penal laws of the Commonwealth," changing the penalties for loitering and prowling at night time.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 418, act of June 24, 1939 (P.L.872), known as "The Penal Code," added May 27, 1949 (P.L.1900), is amended to read:

Section 418. Loitering and Prowling at Night Time.—Whoever at night time maliciously loiters or maliciously prowls around a dwelling house or any other place used wholly or in part for living or dwelling purposes, belonging to or occupied by another, [is guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1000) or undergo imprisonment for a period not exceeding one (1) year, or both.] shall, upon summary conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500), or to undergo imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both.
