Authorizing residents of Maryland to fish in certain reservoirs in Pennsylvania under certain circumstances without obtaining a Pennsylvania fishing license.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Residents of the State of Maryland who possess fishing licenses valid in that state may fish on that portion of the Conowingo and Youghioghney Reservoirs lying within the boundaries of Pennsylvania without obtaining Pennsylvania fishing licenses to do so, but such fishing shall be confined to the reservoirs proper, not including their tributaries.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon the passage of reciprocal action by the State of Maryland.
