## A SUPPLEMENT

## HB 1596

To the act of November 12, 1971 (Act No. 140), entitled "An act providing for the capital budget for the fiscal year 1971-1972," itemizing public improvement projects of the Department of Property and Supplies together with their estimated financial cost.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Short Title.—This supplement shall be known and may be cited as the "Capital Budget Act for Fiscal Year 1971-1972, Public Improvement Project Itemization Supplement—Department of Property and Supplies."

Section 2. Itemization and Authorization of Projects.—Additional capital projects in the category of public improvements, consisting of the acquisition of original equipment and furniture to complete public improvement projects, to be financed-by the incurring of debt, and to be purchased by the Department of Property and Supplies, are hereby itemized together with their estimated financial costs:
