## AN ACT

HB 1332

Amending the act of January 6, 1970 (P.L.434), entitled "An act relating to the Commonwealth Court, implementing section 4 of Article V of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania," eliminating the requirement of Supreme Court approval for the compensation of court personnel.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 7, act of January 6, 1970 (P.L.434), known as "The Commonwealth Court Act," is amended to read:

Section 7. Court Personnel.—The court shall appoint a prothonotary, deputy prothonotaries, an official court reporter and such other personnel as may be necessary to exercise its powers and perform its functions and duties, and shall fix their compensation [with the approval of the Supreme Court] which shall not exceed the amount appropriated annually by the General Assembly. The office of the prothonotary shall be at the seat of government. Deputy prothonotary offices may be maintained in the cities of Philadelphia and Pittsburgh as prescribed by rule of court approved by the Supreme Court. Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
