## AN ACT

HB 78

Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323), entitled "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," authorizing the commissioners to determine when the court house and other county offices shall be open.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 2301.1, act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323), known as "The County Code," added July 17, 1961 (P.L.776) and amended December 8, 1965 (P.L.1053), is amended to read:

Section 2301.1. [Saturday Closing] Days and Hours of Court House and Offices.—[In counties of the third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes, the] The county commissioners [may order that] shall determine when the county court house and all county offices located elsewhere [except voters registration offices during the period of time that persons are eligible to register be closed all day on Saturdays throughout the year or during any specified period of the year.] shall be open, except that voters' registration offices shall be open during ordinary business hours on the two Saturdays prior to termination of registration prior to the primary and general and municipal elections.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
