## AN ACT

## HB 1667

Amending the act of January 18, 1952 (P.L.2128), entitled "An act defining and providing for the licensing and regulation of private driver education or training schools; conferring powers and imposing duties on the Department of Public Instruction; and imposing penalties," reducing certain age requirements.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Clause (a) of subsection (2), clause (a) of subsection (7) and clause (a) of subsection (8) of section 4 of the act of January 18, 1952 (P.L.2128), entitled "An act defining and providing for the licensing and regulation of private driver education or training schools; conferring powers and imposing duties on the Department of Public Instruction; and imposing penalties," are amended to read:

Section 4. The qualifications for licensure and the standards of licensure.

- (2) Teacher and Director Qualifications.
- (a) Every teacher in a school shall be a citizen of the United States, at least [twenty-one (21)] eighteen (18) years of age, and a person of good moral character.
  - \* \* \*

\* \* \*

- (7) Agents.
- (a) Each agent shall be a person of good moral character, a citizen of the United States, and at least [twenty-one (21)] eighteen (18) years of age.
  - (8) Ownership.
- (a) Each individual proprietor of a school, each member of a partnership association or company that owns a school, and each officer and director of a corporation that owns a school, who is directly connected with the conduct and operation of the educational program, shall be a person of good moral character, a citizen of the United States, and at least [twenty-one (21)] eighteen (18) years of age. The said persons and any school employe thereof shall not be addicted to the use of alcoholic liquors, morphine, cocaine or other drugs having a similar effect, and shall not be mentally incompetent.
