## AN ACT

HB 1672

Amending the act of February 1, 1966 (P.L.1656), entitled "An act concerning boroughs, and revising, amending and consolidating the law relating to boroughs," reducing certain age requirements.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1185, act of February 1, 1966 (P.L.1656), known as "The Borough Code," is amended to read:

Section 1185. Age, Applicant's Residence.—No person shall be eligible to apply for examination unless he is at least [twenty-one] eighteen years of age at the date of application. An applicant need not be a resident of the borough. The council of the borough may authorize the commission, by rule or regulation, to require policemen and firemen to become residents of the borough after appointment to such positions.
