A SUPPLEMENT

HB 1594

To the act of November 12, 1971 (P.L. 538), entitled "An act providing for the capital budget for the fiscal year 1971-1972," itemizing public improvement projects to be acquired or constructed by The General State Authority, together with their estimated financial costs.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Short Title.—This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Capital Budget Act for Fiscal Year 1971-1972, Public Improvement Project Itemization Supplement—The General State Authority."

Section 2. Itemization and Authorization of Projects.—Additional capital projects in the category of public improvement projects to be acquired or constructed by The General State Authority, its successors or assigns, and to be financed by the incurring of debt, are hereby itemized, together with their respective estimated financial costs and the total additional amount authorized for public improvement projects, as follows:

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Section 3. Allocation of Funds.—Whenever as determined by The General State Authority, the full estimated financial cost of any of the public improvement projects itemized in section 2 hereof is not necessary for the proper design, acquisition or construction of such project, the excess funds no longer required may be allocated by The General State Authority to increase the estimated cost of any one or more of the public improvement projects specifically itemized in a capital budget.

Section 4. Effective Date.—This act shall take effect immediately.
