## AN ACT

HB 483

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225), entitled "An act concerning game and other wild birds and wild animals; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," specifying the age requirement for permits.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The first paragraph of section 401, act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225), known as "The Game Law," amended October 13, 1965 (P.L.592), is amended to read:

Section 401. Commission: Empowered to Grant Permits.—Under the conditions and limitations hereinafter prescribed, the commission may grant permits at its discretion to citizens of the United States who, unless otherwise specified, shall be residents of the Commonwealth and [twenty-one] eighteen years old or over, which permits shall be in such form as the commission may determine and shall expire on June thirtieth of each year, except the permit for a disabled person to hunt from an automobile, which shall expire on August thirty-first of each year, and which may be revoked or suspended at any time at the discretion of the commission. Such permits shall not be transferable. Such permits may be issued:
