Amending the act of June 1, 1933 (P.L.1172), entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," adding a route in State College, Centre County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of June 1, 1933 (P.L.1172), entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," is amended by adding the following route.

State College

Route 14014. Extending Route 14014.—Beginning at a point on the Ferguson Township-State College Borough Line; thence northeasterly on Whitehall Road to the State College Borough-College Township Line; beginning again on the College Township-State College Borough Line; thence northeasterly on Whitehall Road to a point on Route 307, at South Atherton Street and Whitehall Road, in the Borough of State College, Centre County, a distance of about 1.1 miles.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
