Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323), entitled "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," providing a solicitor for the coroner.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323), known as "The County Code," is amended by adding a section to read:

Section 1252. Solicitor to Coroner. The coroner may appoint one person learned in the law, as his solicitor. Said solicitor shall advise the coroner upon all legal matters that may be submitted to him and shall conduct any litigation in connection with the coroner's office when requested so to do by the coroner.

Section 2. Section 1630 of the act, added August 18, 1967 (P.L.244), is amended to read:

Section 1630. Compensation of Solicitors Appointed by County Officers.—The county commissioners may appropriate money for the payment of any solicitor appointed pursuant to this act by a county treasurer, sheriff, prothonotary, register of wills, recorder of deeds, clerk of courts of quarter sessions and over and terminer, *coroner* or a clerk of orphans' court.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
