Amending the act of April 6, 1830 (P.L.272), entitled "An act for the levy and collection of taxes upon proceedings in courts, and in the offices of register and recorder, and for other purposes," providing that certain fees received by prothonotaries and registers and recorders shall be for the use of the county.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 7, act of April 6, 1830 (P.L.272), entitled "An act for the levy and collection of taxes upon proceedings in courts, and in the offices of register and recorder, and for other purposes," is amended to read:

Section 7. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the prothonotaries of the several courts, and the registers and recorders above mentioned, shall each and all on or before the first day of October, in every year, account for on oath or affirmation, to the Auditor General, and pay into the treasury the several amounts of taxes by them respectively received, previous to the first day of September in each year, in pursuance of this act, deducting therefrom three per centum for the use of the county for receiving and paying over said amount.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately and apply to all prothonotaries and registers and recorders appointed or elected on or after the Tuesday next following the first Monday of November, 1971.
