PROCLAMATION

By virtue of the authority vested in me by Article II, Section 4; Article IV, Section 12; and Article III, Section 12; of the Constitution, I, Milton J. Shapp, Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, do hereby convene the General Assembly in special and extraordinary session, to meet in the Capitol, at Harrisburg, on Monday, August 14, 1972, at 3:00 o'clock p.m., to consider legislation to reform the Pennsylvania Election and Registration Laws to bring them into conformity with the Federal Voting Rights Act Amendments of 1970, and to enact any additional Election and Registration legislation which the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania shall deem appropriate.

GIVEN under my hand and the Great Seal of the State, at the City of Harrisburg, this seventh day of August, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-two, and of the Commonwealth the one hundred and ninety-seventh.
