Amending the act of June 22, 1970 (P.L.378, No.122), entitled "An act concerning nursing homes; providing for the licensing of persons charged with the general administration of such homes; prescribing the powers and duties of the State Board of Examiners of Nursing Home Administrators; fixing fees and making certain acts unlawful," further providing for educational qualifications for admission to examination.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 6, act of June 22, 1970 (P.L.378, No.122), known as the "Nursing Home Administrators License Act," is amended by adding a subsection to read:

Section 6. Qualifications for Admission to Examination .- * * *

(f) Any person who has operated a nursing home for a period of three years or more shall be admitted to the licensing examination without the necessity of submitting written evidence of high school graduation or its equivalent.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply retroactively to June 22, 1970.
