## AN ACT

## **HB 11**

Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to counties of the second class and second class A; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," authorizing appropriations for the payment of legal aid services in counties of the second class A.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Article XXI, act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), known as the "Second Class County Code," is amended by adding a subdivision to read:

## ARTICLE XXI Special Powers and Duties of the County

## (p.1) Legal Aid Services

Section 2199.1A. Appropriations for Legal Aid Services.—The board of commissioners of a county of the second class A may appropriate moneys for payment to nonprofit legal aid associations or societies, or county bar associations, who provide legal aid services for indigent persons in civil matters.
