## AN ACT

SB 406

Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), entitled "An act concerning townships of the second class; and amending, revising, consolidating and changing the law relating thereto," increasing the daily expense allowance and mileage of delegates.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 612, act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), known as "The Second Class Township Code," reenacted and amended July 10, 1947 (P.L.1481, No.567), and amended December 15, 1965 (P.L.1094, No.421), is amended to read:

Section 612. Expenses and Mileage.—The expenses allowed the delegates attending the annual meeting [shall] may be [thirty-five] in an amount not exceeding fifty dollars per day for each delegate for not more than four days including the time employed in traveling thereto and therefrom, together with [ten] twelve cents per mile in going to and returning from such meeting and shall be paid by the respective county associations.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
