Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," increasing the expense allowance and mileage for delegates and officers attending the annual meeting of the State association of township commissioners.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 622, act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as "The First Class Township Code," reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569), and amended December 15, 1965 (P.L.1094, No.420), is amended to read:

Section 622. Expenses of Delegates Paid by Townships.—Each delegate and other officer attending the annual meeting of the State association shall be allowed for his expenses incurred in attending the meeting, [thirty-five] not to exceed fifty dollars per day for not more than four days including the time employed in traveling thereto and therefrom, together with [ten] twelve cents per mile in going to and returning from the meeting. These expenses shall be paid by the respective townships.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
