## AN ACT

SB 238

Amending the act of June 23, 1931 (P.L.932, No.317), entitled "An act relating to cities of the third class; and amending, revising, and consolidating the law relating thereto," reducing the age qualification of a city treasurer to twenty-one years.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1401, act of June 23, 1931 (P.L.932, No.317), known as "The Third Class City Code," reenacted and amended June 28, 1951 (P.L.662, No.164), is amended to read:

Section 1401. Qualifications.—The city treasurer shall be a competent accountant, at least [twenty-five] twenty-one years of age, and shall have been a resident of the city for at least one year next prior to his election. He shall reside in the city throughout his term of office.
